Grading and Ranking

Grade point average is computed beginning in grade 9 with the exception of Honors Algebra in 8th grade. All subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation. A minimum of 48 credits is needed for graduation, however, an Indiana Employment Honors Seal requires a minimum of 57, and a Enrollment Honors Seal requires a minimum of 58 credits. In addition, each student must complete 100 hours of community service. AP and Dual-Credit classes are weighted. Grades are recorded on the transcript, and GPA is computed in January and May. Because of the small class sizes, our students are not ranked.
